Bond Street July 30th 1799

Sir

I have the honor to acquaint you that your Case, containing prints, was shipped for New York on the 26th instant I sent it according to the direction of your Agent, who has the bill of Lading for the same, to Botolph Wharf. I hope the prints of the Washington Family have been, before this, at your Friends at Bristol.

As I had a very fine proof ^{of the sortie} ready strained, exactly fitted your Frame, I was tempted to put it in, and have charged you only as a print. I must however, beg leave to observe that I have not done this from any consciousness that your American Battles were not fine impressions, on the contrary, I certainly meant to send you very fine ones, but as you are not quite satisfied that they were so, I hope that this will make amends.

you will see that you are charged some what higher for the frames and glazings, than you were the last envoy that I made but it is not in my power to do otherwise, as labour as well as glass is much increased in price — on the other side of this paper you will find, as desired, the amount of my bill.
